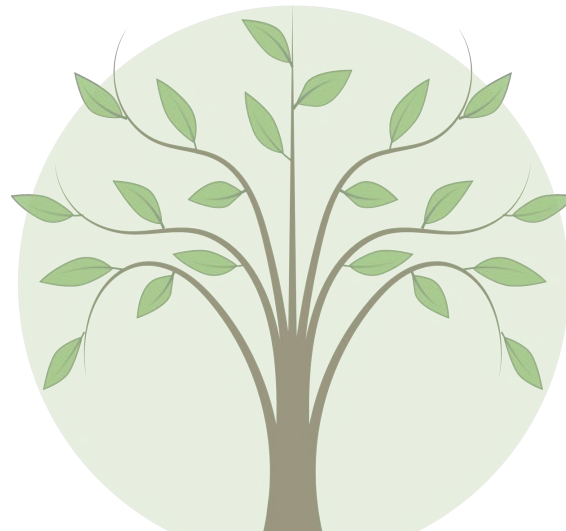





CANE/AIIE is proud to be an associate group of the Canadian Nurses Association.


